Alice's Tips

- ✓ Leave a tail long enough to sew each appliqué to the squares, and at the end of each square.
- ✓ I recommend using a larger hook (4.5mm) for the patterned squares and a slightly smaller hook (4mm) for the plain squares and appliqués.
- ✓ Tension: Plain Square 10 x 10cm.
- ✓ If your patterned squares come out smaller than the plain squares, consider using a different hook size to match tension, or gently block your square to 10x10cm.
- ✓ Beg 1 ch does not count as a st unless otherwise specified.
- ✓ The yarn in this calendar is limited edition, but if you are looking for a close match to make even more gorgeous projects, why not try Scheepjes Softfun DK? www.scheepjes.com

elcome to the Santa's
Workshop blanket!
This pattern has been inspired by
everything we love about the festive season,
from beloved Christmas characters to our
favourite treats.

This blanket is made up of five sections, each with its own theme. You will make two plain squares each day from each colour (10 plain squares per group), as well as the components for the appliqués. At the end of the five days, you will also make 10 patterned squares, chosen to match the theme, resulting in 20 squares for each colour group. You can then assemble all your appliqués and sew them onto the plain squares.
